## Year 5 – 5/6 BYOD Curriculum Overview - Term 3, 2019

### English

- Focusing on persuasive speeches, students will practise note taking skills and speech writing.
- Students will continue to work on spelling, vocabulary, grammar, punctuation and the CAFÉ reading program.



### Mathematics

- Review measurement facts and apply a range of problem solving strategies to measurement problems
- Four operations extending to multiplication by 2 digits and decimals
- Multi step problem solving
- To continue patterns by adding and subtracting fractions and decimals
- Use number sentences to find unknown quantities
- Use a grid reference system to describe location



### Science

Key features of our solar system including planets and stars.



The International Space Station and space explorations research.

### Technology

Students will go through a design process of investigating, generating, producing and evaluating to develop their own edible plant product with packaging and a food fact sheet.

### The Arts

Students will focus on the drama skills of public speaking, miming and improvisation.

They will work collaboratively to perform a role play in a small group.

### Health & Physical Education

Students investigate how physical activity creates opportunities for different groups to work together. Athletics skills will also be a focus.

### Humanities and Social Sciences

Students will focus on Civics and Citizenship through learning about democracy, government and social/environmental issues. Social Responsibility and our ability to impact change will form the basis for our Education Research this term.
