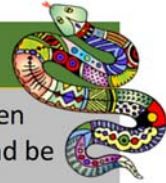

Prep Year Curriculum Overview - Term 3 2019

English



Children will participate in oral and written stories. They will retell familiar stories and be exposed to Dreamtime stories.

Children will continue to develop their reading confidence and continue to learn and implement their reading strategies.

Sight words and Jolly Phonics will continue to be learnt, with a focus on sentence writing and being exposed to red and blue lines when writing.



Mathematics

Children will explore connecting number names, numerals and quantities, including zero, initially up to 20 and then beyond.

Students will investigate and focus on collecting and interpreting data by answering and posing yes/no questions to their peers.



The Arts

Children will explore and respond to digital technologies. They will use iPads to create a retell of a story of their choice. They will learn how to use the digital software called 'Toontastic'.

Science and Technology

Children will investigate using their senses. Throughout this unit of work children will explore the materials that are used to form objects and the observable properties of these materials (wood, plastic, glass, metal, wool). Students will design and create a garden ornament.



Humanities and Social Sciences

Students will investigate the inquiry question, 'What are places like?' They will understand that a 'place' has features and a boundary that can be represented on maps or globes. They will observe and record visible features of the 'place' they live in and belong to.

Health & Physical Education

Students will engage in training for the Junior Sports Day and identify actions and protective behaviours that keep them safe and healthy.
