Year 1 Curriculum Overview - Term 4, 2024



English

Students will engage with a variety of texts that depict characters, settings, and events. Through these texts, students will explore typical stages of narratives and discuss how language and visual features develop characters. They will respond to imaginative texts by expressing reasons for their likes, dislikes, and preferences. Additionally, students will participate in shared and independent writing experiences, culminating in the creation of a text that shares ideas and expresses an opinion about a character from a familiar story.



Humanities and Social Sciences

Students will recognise that people describe the features of places differently and will discuss how places can be cared for. They will also reflect on their learning and suggest ways to care for a chosen place.

Mathematics

Students will practise skip counting by twos, fives, and tens, both forwards and backwards, up to 100. They will also continue patterns involving numbers and objects, and further develop their understanding of partitioning. Additionally, students will predict the outcomes of familiar events and use directional language to navigate from place to place.



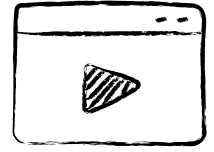
Health and Physical Education

In Physical Education students demonstrate positive ways to interact with others through cooperative games. They will perform movement sequences that incorporate the elements of movement through swimming and soccer. In Health, students will practise strategies to keep themselves safe and rehearse ways to ask for help when presented with a problem or challenging task.



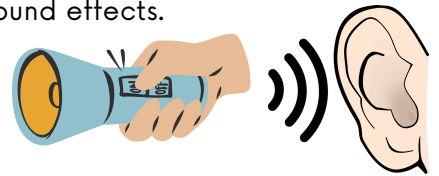
The Arts

Students will explore characters and settings in media artworks inspired by a familiar story. They will use a storyboard to plan their media artwork.



Science

In this unit, students will explore sources of light and sound by manipulating materials to observe how they are produced. They will also investigate how changes can be made to alter light and sound effects.

In Design Technology, students will describe how farms fulfill our requirements and recognise plants and animals that supply us with resources.
