Prep Curriculum Overview - Term 3, 2025









English

This term, students will explore texts that tell simple stories or recount real-life events, such as picture books, informative texts and non-fiction. These texts will support their phonics development and help expand their vocabulary around everyday experiences, personal interests and familiar topics.

Students will participate in shared and independent speaking activities to retell events in sequence and express their thoughts and feelings. They will learn to speak clearly, listen respectfully and take turns in conversations, building their confidence when communicating with others.

Mathematics

Students will continue to develop their proficiency towards mathematics and its applications, they will build on their understanding to make connections between number names, numerals, and quantities, and learn to partition and combine collections. They will explore situations, using physical and virtual materials to represent and solve everyday problems involving quantifying, equal sharing, and adding or taking away from collections up to at least 10. Students will name, create, and compare shapes, using mathematical reasoning. They will also build confidence and autonomy in making and justifying mathematical decisions based on quantification and direct comparisons of mass, capacity, length and duration of objects.

Science

Students will examine familiar objects using their senses and understand that these objects are made from materials with observable properties. Through exploration, investigation, and discussion, they will learn how to describe the properties of materials and how to pose scientific questions.

Humanities and Social Sciences

Students will recognise that places can be represented on maps and models. They will explore 'places' they belong to and observe the features of familiar places. Students will suggest ways they can care for a familiar special place.

The Arts

Students will engage in creating and sharing media artworks. They will explore how stories can be told using images, sound and simple digital tools. Through viewing and talking about media artworks, students will begin to understand where and why these artworks are made.

Health and Physical Education

In Health, students will identify and describe different emotions people experience. They will explore and practise ways to interact with others in various settings. In Physical Education, students will demonstrate personal and social skills by participating in collaborative active games and developing their abilities in preparation for Junior Sports Day.
