Year 1 Curriculum Overview - Term 3



Students will engage with a variety of texts, including picture books, stories, and non-fiction, to develop their ability to express opinions. They will explore how texts are structured and use specific vocabulary to adapt content for different audiences. By responding to and creating texts, students will express their opinions using persuasive language. They will also participate in discussions and deliver short oral presentations, practising how to present their ideas clearly and persuasively to an audience.

Mathematics

Students will explore numbers beyond 100 and learn different ways to represent and work with them. They will solve everyday problems using addition, subtraction, sharing and grouping, and explain their thinking using materials or drawings.

They will also describe and sort 2D and 3D shapes and objects based on their features and recognise these in their environment. Students will make direct and indirect comparisons to measure length, mass, capacity and time using informal units (such as blocks or hand spans), and explain their reasoning in everyday situations.

Science

In this unit, students will explore sources of light and sound by manipulating materials to observe how they are produced. They will also investigate how changes can be made to alter light and sound effects.

Humanities and Social Sciences

In Humanities and Social Sciences (HASS), students will:

- Explore the characteristics of various locations (natural, managed and built)
- Observe and compare weather patterns across different places

The Arts

In Media Arts, students will explore how photographic portraits represent moments in time and how technology can be used to manipulate reality in media artworks.

Design Technologies

In Design Technology, students will describe how farms meet our needs and identify the plants and animals that provide us with essential resources.
