Prep Curriculum Overview - Term 2, 2025



English

Through texts, students will explore how characters and events are represented and the language used to describe them. They will build on their understanding of imaginative texts by examining text structures and language features, including how sentences create meaning and connect print with images. Students will engage in shared and independent writing to create retells of familiar stories. They will use learned vocabulary, sentence boundary punctuation, and their phonics knowledge to spell words.

Mathematics

Students will explore numbers by connecting number names, numerals and quantities. They'll use strategies like counting and subitising to compare collections. Students will engage in hands-on activities to explore adding and subtracting numbers up to 10, solving everyday problems. As they build confidence, they will learn to make and explain mathematical decisions based on comparing quantities and time.



Science

During this unit, students will explore the weather. They will focus on using their senses to explain the weather surrounding them and identify weather symbols. Students will investigate how the weather affects their environment, their day-to-day living, and what they wear.

Humanities and Social Sciences

This term, students will identify important events in their own lives. They will identify how they, their families and friends know about their past and commemorate events that are important to them.



The Arts

Students will explore and present the elements of dance (space, time, dynamics and relationships) in small group and whole class settings.



Health and Physical Education

In Health, students will explore how their bodies are growing and developing, and identify the actions that will keep them healthy, such as diet, hygiene and physical activity.

During PE lessons, they will perform fundamental movement skills and solve movement challenges. They will also participate in their gross-motor development program.
