Aspley East State School Year 1 Curriculum Overview - Term 2, 2025

English

Students will participate in shared reading and viewing of authentic texts including non-fiction texts. These texts may include topics being studied in other learning areas. They will write informative texts about familiar topics. Students will use simple sentences with correct punctuation, some topic-specific words, and accurately spell one- and two-syllable words.

Mathematics

Students will use hands-on materials to explore one- and two-digit numbers, learning to break them down into tens and ones. They will practise skip counting to quantify collections and recognise patterns in numbers, extending their knowledge beyond two digits. Students will also solve addition and subtraction problems to 20, using different strategies and discussing the reasonableness of their answers. They will begin using informal units to measure time and make comparisons of duration.

Science

In this unit, students will describe the observable features of a variety of landscapes and skies. They will consider changes in the sky and landscape, and the impact of these changes on themselves and other living things.

Humanities and Social Sciences

In HASS, students will continue to develop an understanding of the terms past, present, and future. They will also engage in comparing various aspects of their daily lives to those of the past, identifying both similarities and differences.

The Arts

In Dance, students will respond to different cultural dances. They will explore dance sequences using the elements of dance (space, time, dynamics, relationships).

Digital Technologies

During this semester unit, students will collect and display data with meaning. They will learn how to represent simple data in different ways.
