Prep Curriculum Overview - Term 4, 2025



English

Students will engage with a range of informative texts that support learning in English and other subjects. Imaginative texts with similar themes will be used to complement these. They will read and view texts including simple decodable books matched to their phonics learning, as well as picture books, stories and non-fiction texts. Students will explore familiar text types and identify how words and images work together to share ideas. They will take part in shared and independent writing to create short texts about familiar topics using learnt vocabulary, basic punctuation and phonic knowledge to support their spelling.



Mathematics

Students will explore numbers to at least 20 by connecting number names, numerals and quantities. They will compare amounts and use hands-on materials to solve everyday problems such as addition, subtraction, sharing and grouping. Students will represent and partition numbers in different ways and begin to explain their thinking. They will build confidence in making and justifying mathematical decisions. Students will also recognise and create repeating patterns using physical and digital tools, applying their understanding in a range of contexts.

Science

Students will investigate movement and the concepts of rolling, spinning, sliding, bouncing, friction, force and elasticity. They will participate in hands on meaningful experiences during investigations and explicit teaching.

Humanities and Social Sciences

Students explore the place they live in and belong to, and learn to observe and describe its features, and why it is important to them. They explore their own special places, how they feel about them, what makes them special, and how they can care for them (place, environment).



The Arts

Students will explore and present the elements of dance (space, time, dynamics and relationships) in small group and whole class settings.



Health and Physical Education

In Physical Education students will practise fundamental movement skills and movement sequences using different body parts during swimming lessons.

In Health, students will learn about their strengths and simple actions they can take to keep themselves and their classmates healthy and safe.
