Prep Curriculum Overview - Term 2, 2026



English

Through texts, students will build on their understanding of imaginative texts by examining text structures and language features, including how sentences create meaning and connect print with images. Students will engage in shared and independent writing to create retells of familiar stories. They will use learned vocabulary, sentence boundary punctuation, and their phonics knowledge to spell words.

Humanities and Social Sciences

This term, students will identify important events in their own lives. They will identify how they, their families and friends know about their past and commemorate events that are important to them.

The Arts

Students will explore and present the elements of dance (space, time, dynamics and relationships) in small group and whole class settings.

Mathematics

Students will explore partitioning, sorting and combining collections up to 10 in different ways, representing these with numbers. They will compare the size of collections to at least 20. Students will make connections between number names, numerals and position in the sequence of numbers from zero to at least 20.



Digital Technologies

Students will explore common digital systems and practise safe and responsible digital use. They will explore how pictures, objects and symbols can be used to represent data and communicate ideas.

Health and Physical Education

In Health, students will explore how their bodies are growing and developing, and identify the actions that will keep them healthy, such as diet, hygiene and physical activity.

During PE lessons, they will perform fundamental movement skills and solve movement challenges. They will also participate in their gross -motor development program.
