Prep Curriculum Overview - Term 1, 2024



English

Students will explore a range of texts for pleasure, engaging in shared reading, viewing, and storytelling that mirrors their experiences. They will connect with characters, settings, and events, linking ideas to personal experiences. Additionally, students will collaborate with peers to retell brief spoken texts.

They will learn their letters and sounds through the PLD program.

Students will be developing their knowledge of concepts of print and beginning reading behaviours.



Mathematics

Students will connect numerals and quantities from 0 to 10. They will sort and classify objects and create repeating patterns.

Science

Students will explore the five senses and understanding that living things have basic needs, including food, water, sunlight, shelter and air.



Humanities and Social Sciences

Students will have the opportunity to develop a deeper understanding of the concept of family. They will learn to recognise and identify members of their own families as well as understand how family structures can vary from one another.



The Arts

This term, students will engage in Drama, where they'll explore role-playing and dramatic action within various scenarios. Through immersive dramatic play, they'll develop creativity, teamwork, and communication skills.



Health and Physical Education

In Physical Education, students will engage in the Perceptual Motor Program (low level: balance/locomotor). They will develop skills in cross-country running. In Health, students will explore information about what makes them unique, identifying their strengths and achievements. Students will identify safe settings where they can move and play safely and identify actions that keep them safe in different settings.
