Year 1 Curriculum Overview - Term 3, 2024



English

Students will engage with a variety of texts, such as picture books, stories, and non-fiction books, to develop their ability to express opinions. They will explore how texts are structured and use specific vocabulary to share and adapt content for different audiences. By responding to and creating texts, students will express their opinions and learn to use persuasive language. Additionally, they will participate in discussions and give short oral presentations to enhance their learning experience.



Humanities and Social Sciences

In Humanities and Social Sciences (HASS), students will:

- Explore the characteristics of various locations (Natural, Managed, and Built).
- Note the variations in weather across different places.

Mathematics

In Mathematics students will:

- Practice skip counting by twos, fives, and tens (forwards and backwards) to 100.
- Solve simple addition and subtraction problems using a range of strategies.
- Measure the length of objects using informal units and compare the capacity of different containers.
- Tell time (o'clock and half past) and understand duration of time (hours, days, weeks, years).
- Identify and represent one half.

The Arts

Throughout this Drama unit, students will work together to develop and stage a unique puppet show. This presentation will showcase their acquired abilities in puppet crafting, storytelling and dramatic elements.



Health and Physical Education

In Physical Education, students will:

- participate in cooperative games, Sports Day training and hone their soccer skills.

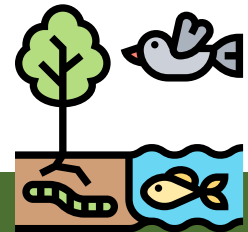
In Health class, students will delve into:
