Provide all teachers to engage in 1 full planning day, each term, to participate in Australian Curriculum Planning, led by the Head of Curriculum	\$82,000
Provide all teachers with 4 hours class release time each term to participate in case management with year level teams and Deputy Principals	\$66,600
Employ additional Education Assistant (Teacher Aide) time to support differentiated teaching and learning programs in English.	\$76,397
Employ a Wellbeing Champion for 1 day each week to support student and staff wellbeing across the school	\$16,750
Employ a Pedagogy Mentor/Coach to lead new teachers in the Aspley East Investigative Approach	\$16,750
Contribute to employment of a full-time Head of Department (Curriculum) to lead curriculum development.	\$37,700
