Student Resource Scheme (SRS) Annual Parent Information Letter



November 2021

Dear Parents/Guardians,

This letter contains important information about the Aspley East State School **2022 Student Resource Scheme (SRS)** including how the scheme operates and the annual participation fee.

The Queensland Government supports students' education by providing funding for:

- Instruction, e.g. teachers
- Facilities, e.g. buildings, amenities, furniture
- Administration, e.g. staffing and resources to administer the operations of the school.

Government funding does not extend to individual student resources such as textbooks, computer or musical equipment for personal use, and many items used/consumed by the student in the classroom. Supply of these items is the responsibility of parents.

To provide parents with a cost-effective alternative to purchasing textbooks and resources elsewhere, Aspley East State School will again operate an SRS for 2022.

The SRS ensures that students have the resources required for them to engage with the curriculum for their education, and saves parents time and money in sourcing the prescribed materials elsewhere. Savings are gained through the school's bulk purchasing practices and hiring arrangements. The scheme is not used to raise funds for other purposes, and revenue collected through the scheme is applied only to the resources and operation of the scheme.

The scheme's operation, resource inclusions and participation fees are approved annually by the school's P&C Association.

SRS Participation

The objective of the scheme is to provide a convenient and cost-effective way for students to access the educational resources necessary to support and enhance their learning experience at school. The Department of Education encourages parents to participate in the scheme. Participation in the SRS is optional, and no obligation is placed on a parent to participate. Participation is for the duration of your child's enrolment at the school.

A parent's participation or non-participation in the scheme will continue as per their previously completed Participation Agreement Form. A parent can opt in or out of the scheme in subsequent years by completing another Participation Agreement Form (included with this letter). For new families and those who have not previously provided us with a Participation Agreement Form, please complete and return it to the school.

Please note if a parent chooses to opt out of the scheme, the parent is required to provide the educational resources listed on the SRS Resource List (included with this letter) for their child by the start of the school year.

Resource Inclusions

All resources provided under the SRS are detailed in the [SRS Resource list](#) included with this letter. This list is also available on our website. This is a comprehensive list of all resources included in the scheme and their associated itemised costs.

Type of Resources provided

Generally, the three types of resources that could be included are:

- **Owned** – these items are retained by the student and used as required (e.g. stationery, exercise books, student diary).
- **Used** – these items are used/consumed in class by the student (e.g. technology/cooking/art supplies). Work or items produced from these resources will remain the property of the student.
- **Hired** – these items are hired to the student for their personal use for a specific period of time (eg. headphones, calculators, iPads, musical instruments).



- Hired items must be returned to the school in good condition at the end of the hire period or if the student leaves the school.
- A repair or replacement cost may be charged to the parent for any hired items that are damaged or not returned.

Costing Methodology

The schools SRS fee is calculated based on a flat fee for all students in the school. Please refer to the [SRS Resource list](#) included with this letter for the associated itemised costings.

The SRS Participation Fees

The general Prep-Year 6 SRS fee for curriculum resources for the year is \$165.00, which is due for payment by Friday, 28th January 2022.

Years 1-3 only - If your child participates in Religious Instruction, an additional annual fee of \$5.00 to cover the Religious Instruction workbook will be payable.

Years 4-6 only - If you have opted out of purchasing an iPad and the related accessories for your child, and therefore opted in to loan a school-owned iPad and accessories, an additional annual fee of \$250.00 will be payable. This loan fee will support the provision of an iPad, an Apple pencil, a keyboard, a protective carry case, and also apps, maintenance, repairs, depreciation of equipment and overall administration for the loan scheme.

Optional in Years 3-6 - If your child participates in Instrumental Music, an annual Instrumental Music SRS fee of \$90.00 will be payable, plus an additional \$50.00 for instrument hire. A resource list for parents opting to not participate in the Instrumental Music SRS is available on our website.

Financial Hardship

Parents experiencing financial hardship who are currently participating or wish to participate in the SRS should contact me to discuss available options in confidence.

Payment Arrangement

Several payment options including a single payment for the full year's fee or term instalments are available, as outlined on the attached Payment Arrangement form. An instalment plan can also be negotiated with the school.

Any unpaid invoices, will be managed according to the department's Debt Management Procedure and may result in the student being excluded from the scheme and/or from participating in non-curricular activities until payment is made (<https://ppr.qed.qld.gov.au/pp/debt-management-procedure>).

Payment Method

SRS payments can be made via QParents/BPOINT, direct deposit or EFTPOS.

- Payment may be made through the QParents portal using a credit card. Payment will be directed from the QParents portal to BPOINT where relevant outstanding invoice information may be selected.
- When paying by BPOINT, please use the Customer Reference Number (CRN) and invoice number printed on the invoice received from the school. If unsure of the CRN, please contact the school.
- Direct deposit can be made to the Aspley East State School General Account, BSB: 064-151, A/C No: 00090072. Please use the reference eg. Mary Smith SRS.
- EFTPOS payments can be made at our Finance Window on Tuesdays & Thursdays from 8.00-9.00am.
